Visit Alameda Land on the island off the coast of Oakland. Though only 10.16 square miles, Alameda has plenty to do both day and night.

Sitting on 25 miles of shoreline, you can easily get your sea air fix along the shoreline pedestrian/bicycle path and beach that stretches along a beautiful two and a half miles on the San Francisco Bay. And it's family and dog-friendly.

Home to an enthusiastic and welcoming sailing and boating community, Alameda has a rich maritime history. And if you like museums, you will have plenty to visit here, including the unique Pacific Pinball Museum.




