Enjoy the great Bay views of many of the urban wineries, craft beer breweries, taprooms and eateries as you create your own tour of this fun island.

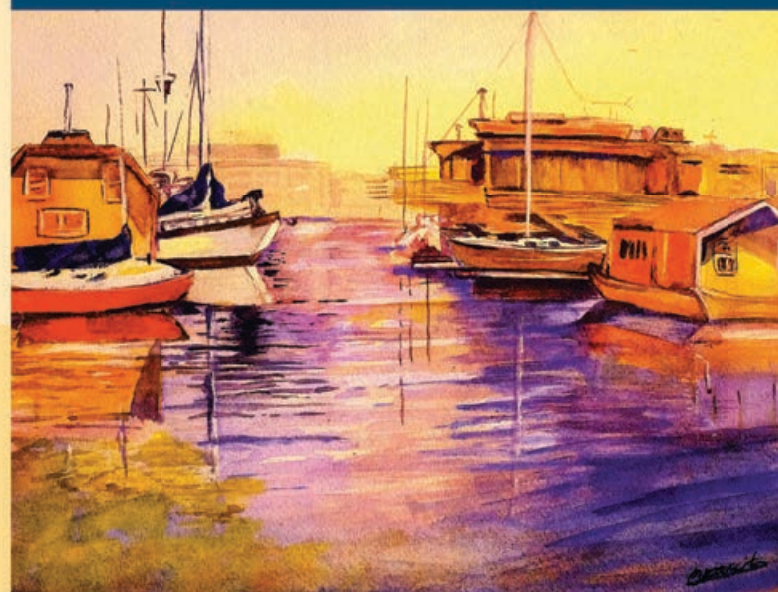

From Hwy 880 you can reach Alameda by car in four ways: 1) Through the Webster/Posey Tunnel 2) Over the Park Street Bridge 3) Over the Fruitvale Railroad Bridge or 4) Over the High Street Bridge. Not enough bridges for you? There's a bridge to take you from Alameda Island to Bay Farm Island! If you're sailing in, dock at one of the many marinas or yacht clubs. Just call ahead for guest dock information.

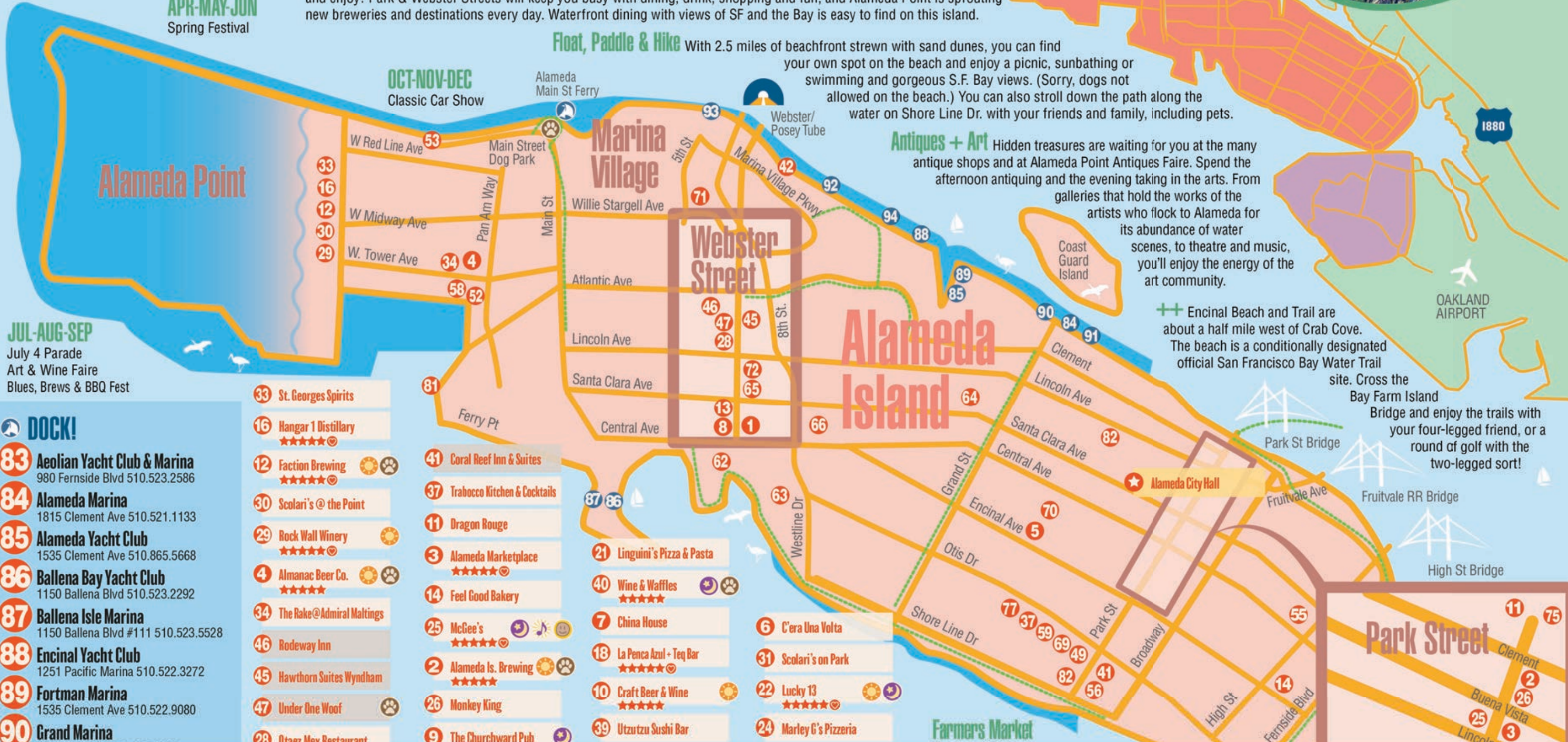
